



GUAM WEATHERIZATION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM



The Guam Environmental Protection Agency/Guam Energy Office (Guam EPA/GEO) in partnership with the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority (GHURA) will be providing weatherization services to eligible clients.

What is it?

The Weatherization Assistance Program is offered to help reduce energy costs for income eligible applicants by improving the energy efficiency of their homes while ensuring their health and safety. The program is geared to assist the elderly, people with disabilities, families with children, high residential energy users, and households with a high energy burden.

What does it do?

The Weatherization Program conducts a full assessment to determine if your house requires any or all of the following:

- * Weather-stripping and sealing of air leaks
- * Installing compact fluorescent light bulbs
- * Replacing refrigerator and/or air conditioner with Energy Efficient models
- * Low flow shower heads and faucet aerators
- * Providing smoke detectors and/or carbon monoxide detectors

Do I qualify?

Weatherization services are FREE to individuals who have met the eligibility criteria based on total household income. Provided below is the income limits based on family size.

Family Size	Maximum Income	Family Size	Maximum Income
1	\$ 27,200	5	\$65,440
2	\$36,760	6	\$75,000
3	\$46,320	7	\$84,560
4	\$55,880	8	\$94,120

*For families with more than 8 persons, add \$9,560 for each additional person.

Documents needed

- * Verification of all household income (i.e. check stubs, VOE, tax return, social security checks, etc.)
- * Social Security Cards for all occupants.
- * Identification - Photo Id
