## 2012 Highlights

Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority (GHURA) along with federal and local partners highlights the following accomplishments in 2012:

GHURA administered 2,391 rental vouchers utilized by 10,472 eligible individuals and families to afford privately-owned rental housing across the island.

GHURA also operated 721 units of public housing, serving 3,110 eligible individuals, families, the elderly, and persons with disabilities.
