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INTRODUCTION

The Point in Time Count (PIT Count) is a federally mandated count from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) of sheltered and unsheltered people experiencing homelessness. The PIT Count provides a snapshot of all those experiencing homelessness in our shelters, streets, beaches, cars, or other places not meant for human habitation, and provides an opportunity to look at trends and demographics of those experiencing homelessness in our community and across multiple years of counts. In 2022, Guam's PIT Count took place over the course of two days on January 27 and 28, 2022.
