Guam's application for the use of CPD funds for the period from October 1, 2017 through September 30, 2018 is submitted to HUD as Guam's PY17 Annual Action Plan (AAP). GHURA selected projects for consideration in the PY17 from proposals received on or before March 30, 2017 in response to Notices of Funding published on January 31, 2017, February 14, 2017 and March 13, 2017. GHURA is inviting the public to comment on the proposed use of funds. A public hearing will be held on Tuesday, July 18, 2017 at 10a.m. at GHURA's Main Office located at 117 Bien Venida Avenue, Sinajana.
