Guam's application for the use of CPD funds for the period from October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019 is submitted to HUD as Guam's PY18 Annual Action Plan (AAP). GHURA selected projects for consideration in the PY18 from proposals received on or before April 5, 2018 in response to Notices of Funding published on February 2, 2018, February 21, 2018 and March 29, 2018. GHURA is inviting the public to comment on the proposed use of funds. A public hearing will be held on Tuesday, July 12, 2018 at 10a.m. at GHURA's Main Office located at 117 Bien Venida Avenue, Sinajana.
