Copies of the bidding documents will be on file and available for inspection beginning on *May 14, 2018* between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. and between 1:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday except on holidays at GHURA Main Office.
