Guam's application for the use of CPD funds for the period from October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020 is submitted to HUD as Guam's PY19 Annual Action Plan (AAP). GHURA selected projects for consideration in the PY19 from proposals received on or before April 5, 2019 in response to Notices of Funding published on February 1, 2019, February 19, 2019 and March 27, 2019. GHURA is inviting the public to comment on the proposed use of funds. A public hearing will be held on Tuesday, July 9, 2019 at 10a.m. at GHURA's Main Office located at 117 Bien Venida Avenue, Sinajana.
