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

Please find attached the Resolution for your approval and adoption of the updated Guam Elderly Multifamily (Guma Trankilidat) Housing Program Administrative Plan which is now called the Tenant Selection Plan. The Tenant Selection Plan has been updated with Sections 102 and 104 to be in full compliance of the Housing Opportunity Through Modernization Act of 2016 (HOTMA) final rule by no later than July 1, 2025. The updated plan has gone through the required 45-day public comment period and public hearing.
