NOTICE OF FUNDING AVAILABILITY for Program Year 2022 Community Planning and Development Funds U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development

The Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority (GHURA) is anticipating the availability of \$4,446,849 in Community Planning and Development (CPD) funds available from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). Eligible government agencies and non-profit organizations are invited to submit proposals that address the priorities and goals identified in Guam's Consolidated Plan Priorities and Goals for 2020-2024. The priorities and goals set forth Guam's plan for supporting low-and moderate-income populations through the creation and preservation of decent housing, sustainable living environments, and economic opportunities for the identified ConPlan term.

Applications for the use of CPD funds are available beginning 10:00am Friday, April 1, 2022, via GHURA's website at www.ghura.org (About GHURA/Community Development/Community Development Applications).

Estimated CPD Program Year 2022 funding allocations are as follows:

Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) \$ 3,125,152.00 HOME Investment Partnership Grant (HOME) \$ 1,063,975.00 Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) \$ 257,722.00

CDBG funds may be used to revitalize neighborhoods, support affordable housing development, expand economic opportunities, and to improve community facilities and services. Use of CDBG funds must meet at least one of the program's national objectives of (1) benefiting low- and moderate-income persons, (2) eliminating slum or blight conditions, or (3) meeting other urgent community development needs. For this estimated program year funding cycle, GHURA will prioritize 65% funds to complete on-going Public Facilities & Infrastructure activities in need of additional funding for completion. A maximum of 15% of the total CDBG Funds may be used to fund Public Service activities received during

HOME funds may be used to create affordable housing for homeowners or homebuyers through financial assistance programs, site acquisition or improvement, or the construction or rehabilitation of housing for rent or homeownership. Use of HOME funds must benefit low-income households.

ESG funds may be used for the rehabilitation or conversion of buildings for use as emergency shelters for the homeless, for the payment of certain expenses related to operating emergency shelters, for essential services related to emergency shelters and street outreach for the homeless, and for homelessness prevention and rapid re-housing assistance.
