GHURA SEEKS FEEDBACK FOR USE OF PROGRAM FUNDS

Sinajaña, GU (October 22, 2019) – The Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority (GHURA) will be drafting a new Consolidated Plan ("ConPlan") for the period 2020-2024. The ConPlan serves as a strategic document that reflects the needs and priorities of the community that are eligible to be addressed with funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

The community needs stated in the ConPlan will be considered for future funding allocation decisions. Thus, GHURA is seeking feedback from the public to help identify community needs and priorities for the 2020-2024 period. GHURA also welcomes public input on eligible activities that should be undertaken to meet the identified needs. Feedback will be gathered on public facilities, neighborhood improvements, housing and homeless assistance, public services and economic development.

In an effort to provide widespread participation, GHURA will launch an online survey available at <u>www.ghura.org</u> from October 23 through November 30. All responses are confidential and will be reported in combination with those of other participants.
