The local CoC recognize that there is a need for supportive services for homeless persons with substance abuse issues however, renewal application was rejected because Elim Pacific Ministries has not demonstrated effective use of federal funds including satisfactory drawdowns and performance for existing grants as evidenced by late submission of payment reimbursements, timely resolution of monitoring findings, and timely submission of required reporting on existing grants. The CoC's plan is to transition existing clients and their children to Housing First Rental Assistance Program for housing assistance and partner organizations to provide support services when operation of Empowered Together expires.
